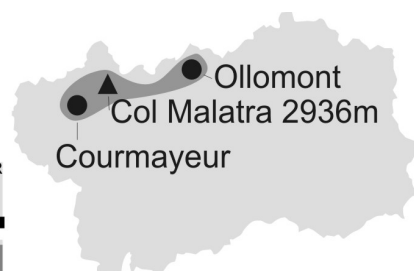
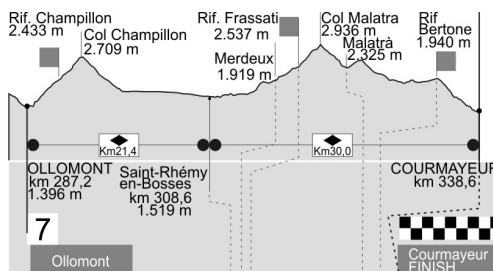

forecast reliability: ★★☆☆




Very cloudy to overcast sky, with showers from the late morning, generally light up to locally moderate and thundery. Clearing up from the South-eastern areas and from the late afternoon/evening.

Winds: 3000 m light or moderate from W/SW, veering North-westerly in the late evening; light Westerlies in the NW valleys while light South-easterlies elsewhere, gusts during the thunderstorms, and foehn winds episodes from the late afternoon in the NW areas, widespread overnight.

Temperatures: falling slightly.
Freezing level: 3800 m; T 1500: 16 °C; T 3000: 5 °C (indicative values in the free atmosphere).



Friday 17 September 2021

forecast reliability: ★★☆☆



Mainly sunny sky in the morning likely. Increasing in cloudiness during the afternoon with some light showers close to Piedmont.

Winds: 3000 m moderate Northerlies, easing and veering from W, and then from SW in the evening; irregular foehn winds episodes in the morning in the valleys, and then breezes in the CNTRL and SE areas.

Temperatures: minimum falling slightly in the valleys, maximum rising slightly.
Freezing level: 3300 » 4000 m; T 1500: 10 » 18 °C; T 3000: 3 » 6 °C (indicative values in the free atmosphere).

Atmospheric pressure: further falling slightly.
